- Read the aims and scope !!
- Read the journal's instruction very carefully
- See a recent journal issue
- See a recent journal paper
- Search Iran at journal website

Ways to find a good journal

- Check the journal metrics
- Indexing: Web of Science (IF?), ESCI, PubMed (Medline), Scopus
- Issues per year: 24,12,6,...?
- Number of papers in each issue
- Acceptance rate
- Rejection rate
- Delay between acceptance and publication
- Open access option
- Publication fee



Steps of submission

- Never send your manuscript by email!
- Go to journal's website
- Create an account
- Insert your ORCID and register yourself
- Corresponding author
- ScholarOne and Editorial Manager submission systems!

ScholarOne



- May suggests reviewers (2 to 5)
- Conditions of suggested reviewers
- Click on the 'Next' button on each screen to save your work and advance to the next screen
- Upload your files by selecting the Item Type
- Some journals require a cover letter
- Some journals require a graphical abstract
- Click 'Build my PDF' to prepare the PDF version.
- View your submission in PDF format, then click 'Approve Submission' to submit your manuscript

Cover letter

- Dear Professor Hasse,
- Please be informed that submitted manuscript entitled "sirolimus versus cyclosporine for the treatment of pediatric chronic immune thrombocytopenia: a randomized blinded trial" is not under review in any journal and all authors are aware of this submission. All authors have had a significant role in this work. We have studied and compared effects of sirolimus with cyclosporine in children with chronic ITP. At present, randomized trials in this field are very scarce and this was our main purpose.

Hope this work would have enough priority to be reviewed in International Immunopharmacology.


After submission

- You will receive a confirmation email after submission
- You can log-in to Editorial Manager at any time to check the status of your manuscript
- ▶ The journal will notify you by email once a decision is made

Who is editor in chief?

Peer review



What is the reviewer looking for?

Originality, scientific significance, conciseness, precision, and completeness

Reviewers will check:

- What is the main question addressed by the research? Is it relevant and interesting?
- How original is the topic? What does it add to the subject area compared with other published material?
- Is the paper well written? Is the text clear and easy to read?
- Are the conclusions consistent with the evidence and arguments presented? Do they address the main question posed?

Minor checks

- Are the correct references cited? Are citations excessive, limited, or biased?
- Are there any factual, numerical, or unit errors? If so, what are they?
- Are all tables and figures appropriate, sufficient, and correctly labelled?

Possible outcomes of peer review

- Accept without any changes (acceptance): The journal will publish the paper in its original form. This type of decision outcome is rare
- Accept with minor revisions (acceptance): The journal will publish the paper and asks the author to make small corrections. This is typically the best outcome that authors should hope for
- Accept after major revisions (conditional acceptance): The journal will publish the paper provided the authors make the changes suggested by the reviewers and/or editors
- Revise and resubmit (conditional rejection): The journal is willing to reconsider the paper in another round of decision making after the authors make major changes
- Reject the paper (outright rejection): The journal will not publish the paper or reconsider it even if the authors make major revisions

How to respond to a major revision?

- Respond to all of questions vey carefully and politely
- "done"
- "corrected"
- Use references when appropriate
- Make all changes requested by reviewers
- Highlight them in the text
- Prior to deadline submit the revised manuscript and wait for final decision

After acceptance

- Before your accepted article is published online, it goes through the production process
- You will receive a proof for final correction
- After that it will be online
- After that it will be published in a issue
- After that it will be available at ISI, PubMed, Scopus
- Then you will enjoy your paper and its credits
